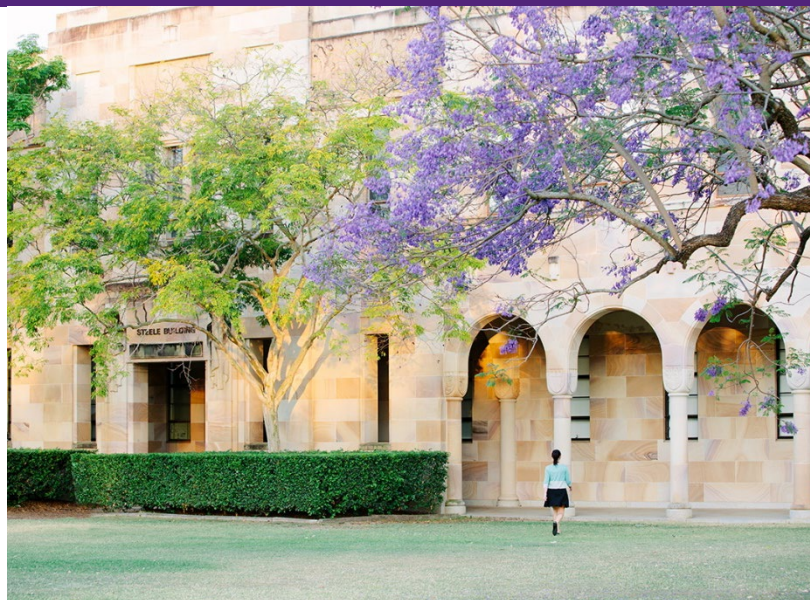

# Graduate Entry for university graduates

Doctor of Medicine, 4 years at UQ

Can apply in your final year of bachelor's or master's degree *or* within 10 years after graduation from your degree

Your degree can be from UQ or any accredited universities recognised by UQ.

Your degree can be in any disciplines as long as you will have met the two MD subject prerequisites.



# Graduate entry requirements

## GAMSAT or MCAT

## GPA

## Subject Prerequisites

GAMSAT: 50 in each section  
*For 2025 intake, UQ accepts scores obtained from September 2020 onwards.*

Or

MCAT: 504

*For 2025 intake, UQ accepts scores obtained from February 2021 onwards.*

A minimum GPA of 5.0 on UQ's 7-point scale in a **key degree** (completed within 10 years prior to program commencement)

*As a guideline, for Canadian students: a minimum 75% or 3 out of 4*

Complete two subject prerequisites.

- **Integrative Cell and Tissue Biology\*** and
- **Systems Physiology\***

\*or equivalent courses in your degree

# Graduate entry requirements - MMI

## Multiple Mini Interview

---

- Invitation to interview will be based on the ranking of GPA (50%) and GAMSAT / MCAT (50%).
- Interviews will be held online.
- After interview, applicants will be ranked in merit order based on GPA (25%), GAMSAT / MCAT (25%) and MMI score (50%).
- Assesses personal qualities, such as empathy, integrity, adaptability and verbal communication skills.

# Application Deadlines

## Graduate Entry

- **Apply on UQ website or through an authorised UQ agent (Canada: OzTREKK)**
- **Application rounds:** early June, early August
- **MMI rounds:** July, September
- **Offer rounds:** August, October
